7	Country Centre, Ferring	<i>Stables, fields. Garden Centre, Rife.</i> Meet in the car park, coffee in the café after painting. Charge for the farm.
14	Field Place Manor House	<i>Gardens and buildings.</i> Entrance on the corner of The Blvd. and Bolsover Rd., Worthing. Car park and facilities.
21	Swanbourne Lake, Arundel	<i>Lake, wildlife, boats, café building.</i> Park on Mill Road Arundel. Toilets available. Meet at Café.
28	St. Andrews Church, Ferring	<i>Church, gardens, old buildings.</i> In the heart of the Village. Parking on the road. Toilets and café in the village.

2	Sullington Manor Farm	<i>Church, farm buildings, views of the Downs.</i> Sullington Lane, Storrington. Turn left off A283. Meet in church car park. Café and facilities.
16	Ham Manor Golf Club, Angmering	<i>Views over golf course, Manor House, lake and fountain etc.</i> A259, pass Sainsbury's to roundabout. Go back towards Ferring on the A259. Take first left onto South Drive (opp. Sainsbury's) then left onto West Drive round to the right.
23	Bailiff's Court Hotel and Spa	<i>Interesting buildings and grounds.</i> Turn left off the A259 at Climping Street. Hotel sign on the right near bottom of the road. Enter drive and meet in the spa car park. Toilets and cafe.

30	Worthing Pier and Marine Parade	<i>The pier, boats and buildings, including The Dome Cinema.</i> Parking along the sea front with 2 hour time limit. Parking tickets required. Many cafes and toilet facilities.

6	St. Mary's House and Gardens, Bramber	<i>Beautiful historic house with pretty gardens and large pond, village, castle and bridge.</i> A27 eastbound to Shoreham and A283 intersection, left onto A283 towards Steyning. At roundabout take 4 th exit into Bramber village. Car park on left with venue opposite. Toilets and refreshments. £10 Donation. Refreshments £4 extra.
13	Old Flint House, Ferring	<i>Lovely garden and property home of "Bushy".</i> End of Church Lane, Ferring, near St. Andrews Church.
20	Patching	<i>Church, cottages in the village, views of the Downs.</i> Car park at the the church.
27	Riverside, Houghton Bridge	<i>Views of bridge over the Arun from the tearoom.</i> A27 to Arundel A284 to Bury Hill roundabout, 3 rd exit B2139 towards Houghton Bridge and Amberley. Toilets & refreshments.
September 2025 (Thursdays)		
4	Steyning Village and St. Andrews Church	<i>Church, picturesque cottages and streets.</i> Plenty of car parking, toilets and lots of tearooms.
11	Thakeham Church	<i>Attractive Church with views over farmland.</i> A24 north of Washington roundabout, turn left for Thakeham. Next roundabout turn right B2139, pass new housing, go to next mini roundabout, sharp right onto The Street. Church at the bottom. Car Parking, toilets, refreshments in village café shop.
18	Ilex Way at Sea Lane, Ferring	<i>Trees with views to the sea over Goring Gap.</i> Meet at entrance to Ilex Way at Sea Lane end Some parking Toilets and refreshments in village.
25	Bluebird Café, Ferring	<i>Beach huts, Rife etc. End of season with group. Maybe coffee together?</i> Parking behind the beach huts. Toilets.
